Despite a complicated history, a hydropower plant, and its dam, Jongno is still considered as the symbol of Seoul and the Korean culture. As one of the most symbolic city in South Korea, it is even referred to as "the jewel city." The location of Jongno is located in the southwest part of downtown Seoul. The city is very near Gyeongbok Palace where the king was the supreme ruler of the entire nation. It is also near to Cheonggyecheon stream which used to be a heart of Seoul. The location has an influence on the city of Seoul with many renowned historical and cultural institutions located in Jongno. A leading street market, Sungnyemun market, is located at the city's east, the building which used to be Korean Central News Agency was located there. Dongdaemun area is considered as the center of Seoul where many companies including banking, insurance, media, and politics are located. The area is also the largest employment center in Seoul, it has more than fifty companies. It is the place where Seoul's workers live. The area was mainly for farming and grazing until the twentieth century. But due to the rapid development of Seoul as a global city, the area is now a major market in South Korea with many tourist attractions. It is also the location of the largest wholesale market in Seoul, Bazaar Town, the Tintwon market is located there. Dongdaemun is also the location of Seoul Broadcasting System's headquarters. Near the end of the 19th century, Jeollabuk-do and Jeollanam-do were connected to Seoul and became the province of Seoul. This area has many universities including Yonsei University and Korea University, South Korea's largest university, Yonsei's sports campus is located in the area. Rise of Seoul In 1965, Seoul became one of the twelve

metropolitan cities of South Korea. With the development of the surrounding areas in the metropolitan area, the area has become a thriving global city. In the year 1995, the South Korean government proposed a plan for the regeneration of the Seoul Capital Area, a project which would greatly redevelop Seoul. The plan included the construction of several new skyscrapers, the upgrade of the public transport system, and the construction of Seoul Forest as well as recreational areas. As Seoul grew, the capital area became congested and suffered from air pollution. The city's boundaries also have to be expanded. Seoul is the fastest growing city
